

**DECISION ON THE SPECIAL SESSION OF THE AU CONFERENCE OF  
MINISTERS OF HEALTH DEDICATED TO <sup>1</sup>SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE  
HEALTH IN AFRICA – DOC.EX.CL/316 (X)**

**The Executive Council:**

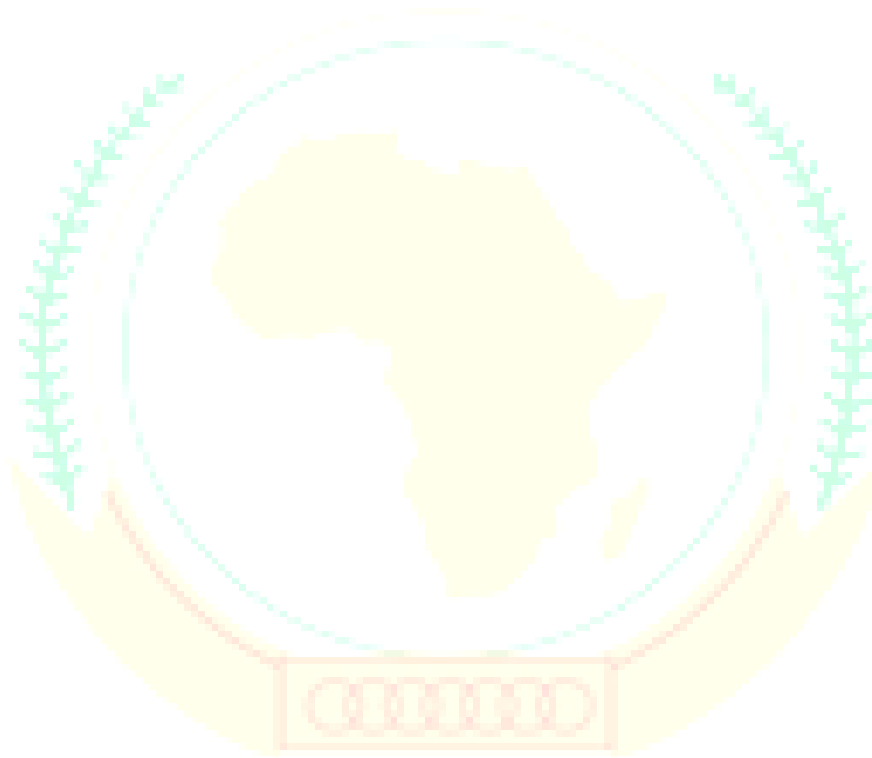
1. **TAKES NOTE** of the Report of the Special Session of the AU Conference of Ministers of Health on Sexual and Reproductive Health in Africa held in Maputo, Mozambique in September 2006;
2. **ACKNOWLEDGES** the efforts of various UN agencies, International Organizations, other development partners, and NGOs in assisting Member States in improving maternal and newborn health;
3. **RECOGNIZES** the role of Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights in the attainment of Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD) goals;
4. **ENDORSES** the Maputo Plan of Action for the Operationalization of the Continental Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights Policy Framework in Africa;
5. **URGES** Member States to allocate adequate resources for the improvement of maternal and child health in Africa;
6. <sup>2</sup>**FURTHER URGES** Member States to implement the Maputo Plan of Action for the Operationalization of the Continental Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights Policy Framework in Africa in conformity with their national laws;
7. **APPEALS** to the International Community to continue to provide necessary assistance towards the attainment of the objectives contained in the Maputo Plan of Action for the Operationalization of the Continental Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights Policy Framework in Africa;
