
## The Executive Council:

- 1. TAKES NOTE of the Report of the Special Session of the AU Conference of Ministers of Health on Sexual and Reproductive Health in Africa held in Maputo, Mozambique in September 2006;
- 2. ACKNOWLEDGES the efforts of various UN agencies, International Organizations, other development partners, and NGOs in assisting Member States in improving maternal and newborn health;
- 3. RECOGNIZES the role of Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights in the attainment of Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD) goals;
- 4. ENDORSES the Maputo Plan of Action for the Operationalization of the Continental Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights Policy Framework in Africa;
- 5. URGES Member States to allocate adequate resources for the improvement of maternal and child health in Africa;
