Your Excellency,

I requested the Belgian-based Anti-Apartheid and Anti-Colonialism Committee to assist in the compilation of addresses of all Anti-Apartheid movements in Western Europe and I got the list herein enclosed.

These organizations are very useful in the campaign against apartheid in Europe. I thought that the political department might find this list useful for purposes of launching an international campaign against apartheid.

On another point, you might also wish to have an idea of the types of sanctions which were adopted by the United States this year. The one I have enclosed is an extract from the Boston Globe Newspaper of Friday, 3rd October, 1986. As soon as I manage to get the official text, I will compare it with the watered-down measures adopted by the EEC in September this year for purposes of re-launching the campaign for sanctions in Western Europe.

EEFECTS OF SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON SOUTH AFRICA

"WASHINGTON - Following are the effects of sanctions that Congress imposed against South Africa yesterday as a result of the Senate vote to override President Reagan's veto of sanctions legislation:

FINANCIAL

The bill bans all new public and private loans and investments in South Africa except for reinvesting profits rescheduling of existing debt. The ban exempts loans and credits for education, housing or humanitarian projects and investments in firms owned by black South Africans.

Remaining US investments in South Africa last year totaled \$31.3 billion. As of last March. US banks held \$329million in deposits by South African banks and government agencies. Outstanding loans to South African government agencies totaled \$148 million last year.

The bill would not require disinvestment, or withdrawal of existing loans or investments from South Africa.

IMPORTS

US imports of South African iron, steel, arms, ammunition, military vehicles and farm products are prohibited immediately. A ban on imports of uranium, coal and textiles are transferred to the Philippines. Any direct or indirect imports from South African state-owned companies also are prohibited.

US government agencies are prohibited from buying goods

and services from South Africa, promoting tourism to South Africa

EXPORTS

The measure bans exports of petroleum products, crude

or cooperating with the South African military except for intelligence-gathering activities. The bill terminates a 1946 bilateral treaty intended to prevent businesses from paying taxes on the same income to both countries.

PENALTIES

Corporations would be subject to maximum fines of \$1 million for each violation of the sanctions legislation. Individuals could be fined up to \$50.000 and imprisoned up to five years".
