RESOLUTION

The Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its Fourth Ordinary Session in Kinshasa, Congo, from 11 to 14 September 1967,

<u>Solemnly re-affirming</u> their adherence to the principle of respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Member States,

Reiterating their condemnation of secession in any Member States,

Concerned at the tragic and serious situation in Nigeria,

<u>Recognizing</u> that situation as an internal affair, the solution of which is primarily the responsibility of Nigerians themselves,

Reposing their trust and confidence in the Federal Government of Nigeria,

<u>Desirous</u> of exploring the possibilities of placing the services of the Assembly at the disposal of the Federal Government of Nigeria,

<u>Resolves</u> to send a consultative mission of 6 Heads of State, (Cameroon, Congo (Kinshasa) Ethiopia, Ghana, Liberia and Niger) to the Head of the Federal Government of Nigeria to assure him of the Assembly's desire for the territorial integrity, unity and peace of Nigeria.
