RESOLUTION ON THE INCREASE ON THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BUREAU OF THE ASSEMBLY

The Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the Organization of African Unity, meeting in its Thirty-First Ordinary Session in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 26 to 28 June, 1995,

<u>Desirous</u> of ensuring and equitable geographical representation on the Bureau of the Assembly,

<u>Considering</u> that due to the recent admission of new Member States into the OAU and increase in the activities of the Organization, it is necessary to increase the number of the membership of the Bureau of the Conference,

<u>Considering further</u> Rule 9 of the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly of Heads of State and Government which stipulates that at the beginning of each session, the Assembly shall elect the Chairman of the Assembly and eight meeting chairmen,

<u>Considering</u> also the appropriate recommendation formulated by the Council of Ministers at its Sixty-Second Ordinary Session held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 21 to 23 June, 1995,

1. **INVOKES** the provisions of Rule 38 of the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly and DECIDES to amend Rule 9 thereof to increase the number of meeting Chairmen from eight to fourteen.
