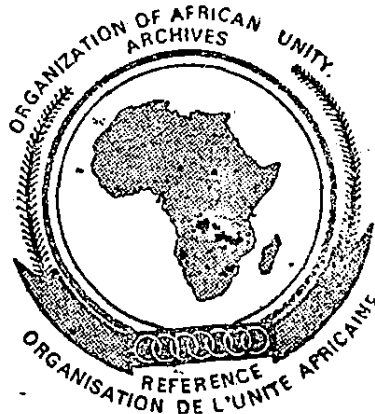

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to forward herewith an application for subvention on behalf of the African Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions (AFROSAI) for the year 1982/83 financial year.

AFROSAI was established in November, 1976 in CAMEROON in the presence of a representative of the OAU Secretary-General and has since 1978 been granted an OAU observer Status. It's primary aim is "... to ensure close cooperation among its members so as to ensure an African regional integration..." As far as auditing and management of Public Finances are concerned, the modern auditing of Public Finances is no longer based on Regulations. It is essentially based on the efficiency, effectiveness and the management performance of the bodies which participate in the activities of State and para-Statal Establishments.

Consequently, the auditing of Public Finances is gradually becoming more vital in the economic development process.

Resolutions taken recently by the United Nations emphasise the important role played on the control of Public Finances in the economic development and recommended that training at national, regional, inter-regional levels in field of the control of Public Finances be accelerated.

AFROSAI which has to contribute necessarily to the effective control of Public Finances in OAU Member States in order to attain its statutory objectives, is lending a helping hand to the economic development of these States, having been encouraged by the recent resolutions of the United Nations.

The Steering Committee of AFROSAI has decided to intensify its training programmes but is handicapped by its limited financial resources derived from its own budget drawn from contributions from very small number of Member States.

It is for this reason that AFROSAI is applying for a subvention from the OAU up to 50% of its budget prerepresenting an amount of US\$897,320, to finance its activities during the 1982/83 financial year. The programme of its activities for the 1982/83 period amounting to US\$194,620 is attached to this application.

Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurances of my high consideration.

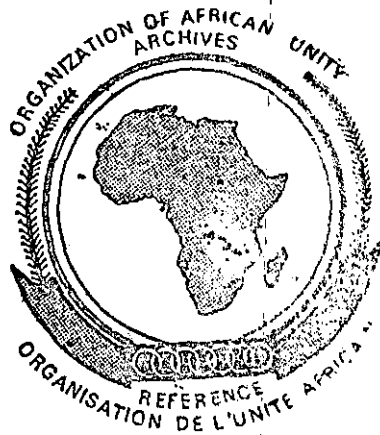
