CHAIRMAN OF THE AFRICAN GROUP FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH**

**ON BEHALF OF THE AFRICAN GROUP  
INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF RACISM AND RACIAL  
DISCRIMINATION**

**NEW YORK, 21 MARCH 2014**

Mr. President,

I have the honor to speak on behalf of the African Group in commemoration of the International Day for the Elimination of Racism and Racial Discrimination on the theme, **“The Role of Leaders in Combating Racism and Racial Discrimination”**. By sheer coincidence, the symbolism of this theme cannot be lost on us that the legacy of one of Africa’s Iconic leaders, the late Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela manifests itself, a driving force for the elimination of racial discrimination in his own country, South Africa.

For the African Group welcomes this annual event as an opportunity to, not only join collective efforts in raising awareness about the pernicious impact of racism but more importantly to assess progress in our common struggle to combat racism and racial discrimination through the effective implementation of the Durban Declaration and Program of Action.
