The Executive Council:

- **1. TAKES NOTE** of the Report
- 2. In accordance with UN Resolution 39/248 on Consumer Protection, **CALLS ON** Member States to protect the welfare of consumers against, inter-alia, dangerous products, unfair business practices, as well as sub-standard goods;
- **3. FURTHER CALLS UPON** Member States to enter into policy dialogue with their consumers on the issue of all forms of exploitation and all forms of unfair business practices;
- **4. URGES** Member States to promote consumer protection and consumer education in their respective countries.
