1. The African Union is the appropriate platform for the realization of the vision of an integrated, prosperous and peaceful Africa, governed by its citizens and representing a dynamic force in the global arena.
2. Niger, like the fifty-three (53) Member States of the African Union subscribes to this common approach to define and implement policies and programmes consistent with the principles and ideals of the Organization.
3. In this regard, as a founding member of the Organization of African Unity which gave birth to the African Union, Niger is and remains committed to contributing to the objectives pursued by both the founding fathers and those who succeeded them and thereby meet the multifaceted challenges facing the continent.
4. To further demonstrate this commitment, Niger has decided to play host to one of the most important events in the operation of the Organization, namely the Assembly of Heads of State and Government.
5. The Government of Niger has therefore decided to host the 33rd Ordinary Session of the Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the AU in June/July 2019 in Niamey.
