

**DECISION ON AFRICA-EU MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE ON  
MIGRATION AND DEVELOPMENT – DOC. EX.CL/313 (X)**

**The Executive Council:**

1. **TAKES NOTE** of the Report of the Africa-EU Ministerial Conference on Migration and Development held in Tripoli, Libya in November 2006;
2. **ENDORSES** the Joint Africa-EU Declaration on Migration and Development;
3. **URGES** Member States to allocate adequate resources for the implementation of the recommendations contained in the Joint Africa-EU Declaration on Migration and Development;
4. **APPEALS** to the International Community to continue to provide assistance towards the attainment of the objectives contained in the Joint Africa-EU Declaration on Migration and Development;
5. **REQUESTS** Member States and the Commission to take part in the Global Forum on Migration and Development scheduled from 9 – 11 July, 2007 in Brussels, Belgium as a follow-up to the UN High Level Session on Migration in September 2006;
6. **MANDATES** the Commission to develop an implementation plan of the Joint Africa-EU Declaration on Migration and Development;
7. **REQUESTS** the Commission, in collaboration with the International Organization for Migration and other partners, to advocate for the implementation of the Joint Africa-EU Declaration on Migration and Development;
8. **ALSO REQUESTS** the Commission to report on the outcome of the Global Forum on Migration and Development to the January 2008 Ordinary Session of the Executive Council;
9. **FURTHER REQUESTS** the Commission to submit a progress report on the implementation of the Joint Africa-EU Declaration annually to the Executive Council.
