TO THE REPORT OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE SECRETARY GENERAL
ON AFRICAN CANDIDATURES FOR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

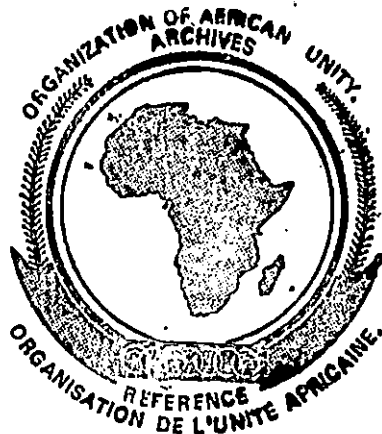


1. The General Secretariat of the Organization of African Unity has received two notes from the Federal Government of Nigeria through its Embassy in Addis Ababa requesting the Secretariat to make known the wish of the Nigerian Government to be re-elected in the following bodies at the end of the present term:

- (a) United Nations Commission on International Trade Law,
- (b) The Industrial Development Board of UNIDO,
- (c) In two subsidiary bodies of the Trade and Development Board namely the Committees on:
 - (i) shipping
 - (ii) invisibles and financing related to trade.

2. The Secretariat has also received a request from the UAR Government to circulate the candidature of Dr. Kayssouni to the Presidency of the African Development Bank. The UAR note was circulated to member states.

3. The Council is, therefore, advised to take into consideration the above candidatures in considering the relative vacancies.
