AFRICAN CANDIDATURES FOR THE POST OF DIRECTOR-GENERAL IN MAJOR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

During the discussion of the item on African candidatures, the Council of Ministers requested that all candidatures for the post of Director-General in major international organizations and all other candidatures of the kind be referred to the Assembly of Heads of State and Covernment for their possible decision.

The candidatures are:

- the candidature of the Arab Republic of Egypt for the post of Director-General of FAO;
- Tunisia's candidature for the post of Director-General of the International Telecommunications Union;
- 3. the candidature of the Republic of Dahomey for the post of Director-General of the International Labour Office;
- 4. Algeria has also put forward its candidature for the post of President of the 29th Session of the General Assembly.

The Assembly of Heads of State and Government is to take a decision on these candidatures.
