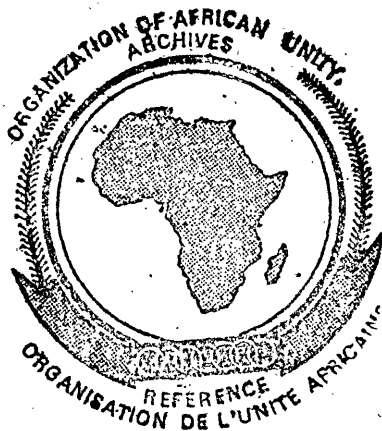

Subject: Request for Subvention

Mr. Secretary-General,

We have the honour to call your attention to the fact that the scope of youth activities is expanding from year to year at the same time as the need increases for all our countries to follow their development closely and give them a political, civic and moral education that will make them fully aware of their role as builders of the new African Society.

This is a major task to which our Movement is devoting itself more and more as it is convinced that with the imminent end to conventional colonial domination for which we have survived Africa will have to become self-reliant to overcome the economic and cultural gap.

It is not easy, however, to attain this objective because it requires enormous investments. But, in the present state of affairs our resources are insufficient to enable us meet all our needs.

This is why, we have the honour, Mr. Secretary-General, to request that you be kind enough to assist us obtain the sum of US\$ 200,000 to help us implement our programme of activities which comprises mainly:-

1. Meeting of the Committee on Cultural Affairs and Festivals;
2. Meeting of Exchange Committee;
3. Meeting of Training Committee;
4. Meeting of Committee on Children;
5. Meeting of Committee in charge of Students Affairs and the General Conference of African Students;

6. Conference of Solidarity of West European and African Youths with the liberation movements of Southern Africa;
7. Conference of Youth of the Third World;
8. Annual Session of the Executive Committee of the PYM;
9. Preparation of Second Pan-African Festival;
10. Running of Main Office.

We are deeply grateful to the OAU for the substantial assistance it has always given to the Youth Movement and we are convinced that the forthcoming Ministerial Session will accord the necessary attention to our request.

Please accept, Mr. Secretary-General, the assurance of our highest consideration.
