

**AFRICA'S REPRESENTATION WITHIN THE VARIOUS ORGANS OF THE
UNITED NATIONS**

**The Assembly of Heads of State and Government meeting in its First
Ordinary Session in Cairo, UAR, from 17 to 21 July 1964,**

**Having studied the Report of the Permanent Representatives at the United
Nations of Ghana, Ivory Coast, Morocco and Niger, commissioned by the
Second Session of the Council (CM/Res. 11(II) to negotiate for the ratification
of amendments to the Charter of the United Nations, recommended by the 18th
Session of the General Assembly;**

- 1. ENDORSES with appreciation the Report of the Permanent
Representatives of Ghana, Ivory Coast, Morocco and Niger;**
- 2. INVITES the African States that have not yet ratified the amendments to
the Charter of the United Nations, to effect ratification of the same before
August 31, 1964;**
- 3. AUTHORIZES African Ambassadors in non-African capitals to impress
upon such Governments the importance of ratifying the amendments;**
- 4. INSTRUCTS the Permanent African Representatives at the United
Nations to continue their efforts so as to obtain the ratification of the
proposed amendments to the Charter of the United Nations.**
