INTRODUCTORY NOTES TO THE 1967/1970 BUDGET

In this Budget, the General Secretariat has endeavoured to maintain the structure of the OAU Budget as has already been established and standardized. Likewise, the establishment, as well as the grade of almost all the posts within the General Secretariat, the Regional Offices and the Sub-Regional Offices have been maintained in line with the decision of the Council of Ministers during its previous Meetings. It will also be observed that under "Personal Emoluments", considerable effort has been exercised by the General Secretariat to keep expenditure as much as possible to the levels of the previous Budget. However, since practically all the personnel would have completed one year of service with the Organization by the time this Budget becomes effective, the salary provided for each post has been increased by one step, in accordance with the provisions laid down in the OAU Staff Rules and Regulations.

Increase and decrease.

In general, the increase and decrease shown mainly in the "Common Staff Costs", "Travel on official duty", "Miscellaneous supplies and services", "Capital Expenditure", and other relevant parts of this Budget is merely an attempt to redress the inadequate position of previous appropriations. In these and subsequent parts of the present Budget, appropriations have been based on the actual expenditure connected with the financial year 1967/1968. Likewise, the increase in number of personnel on existing posts and in the work of the Organization have also been taken into account.

Commission of Mediation, Conciliation and Arbitration.

As directed by the Council of Ministers during its Twelfth Ordinary Session held in Addis Ababa in February 1969, the appropriations of the Commission of Mediation, Conciliation and Arbitration have been incorporated into the main Budget of the General Secre-

tariat and could be found at Part IX-d of this Budget.

The Total Budget 1969/1970 as approved by the Council.

At the plenary meeting of the Session, the total amount of the 1969/1970 Budget was given as US.\$ 2,412,261.00. The additions have been carefully checked and the correct figure is US.\$ 2,401,209.00.

Implementation of Resolutions.

Chapter IX, paragraph 5 of Document CM/40 "Financial Rules and Regulations", provided for the following :

- Resolutions involving expenditure :

"The Council of Ministers, the Specialized Commissions and all other duly constituted"  
"Committees and Organs shall not take any decision involving expenditure unless they"  
"have before them a report from the Administrative Secretary-General on the adminis-"  
"trative and financial implications of the proposal on the current financial year. "  
"When, in the opinion of the Administrative Secretary-General, the proposed expendi-"  
"ture cannot be made from the existing appropriations, it shall not be incurred un-"  
"til the Council of Ministers has made the necessary appropriations, unless the Ad- "  
"ministrative Secretary-General certifies that provisions can be made under the con-"  
"dition of the special Resolution of the Council of Ministers relating to unfore- "  
"seen and extraordinary expenses. "

During the last Summit Meeting in Algiers, September 1968, a certain number of Resolutions involving financial implications have been adopted. The necessary financial provisions for the implementation of these Resolutions have therefore been made and would be found at Part X of this Budget.

- (1) In accordance with the Staff Rules and Regulations, on first appointment, the transportation expenses of Staff from their homes to the Headquarters or their official duty stations, may be paid by the Organization. It is anticipated that up to 12 Statutory Staff Members will be appointed within this financial year. The amount of US.\$ 12,000.00 is expected to cover the travel expenses of the new Staff and their families.
- (2) The Staff Rules and Regulations also provide for home leave and seperation. Twenty-four Staff Members will be due for home leave and seperation of duty during the period covered by this Budget. Therefore, those due for home leave will be entitled for tourist class round trip air tickets while those on seperation will be paid one way tickets.
- (3) In accordance with the Staff Rules and Regulations, Staff Members are entitled to initial installation and dependency allowances, gratuity on the completion of service and comprehensive insurance coverage whilst in service with the Organization of African Unity. Financial provision has, therefore, been made in respect of installation and dependency allowances and gratuity on completion of service.
- (4) Item 8 - a/c code 207 : OAU Insurance and Social Security Scheme.

In the Staff Rules and Regulations, it is stated in Section 5, Article 3, Paragraph 1, that the Organization shall establish a comprehensive scheme for Members of the Secretariat employed by the Organization. The Ninth Ordinary Session of the Council of Ministers held at Kinshasa in September 1967 approved the Document CM/177 dealing with the establishment of a compensation insurance scheme. The insurance premium on the insurance policy on each Staff Member or Employee shall be equal to 5 % of the basis annual salary or wage of a Staff Member.

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Explanatory Notes :1. Multinational co-operation in Africa

Authority : Resolution CM/Res.159 (XI), passed by the Council of Ministers in its Eleventh Ordinary Session.

Description: Economic co-operation, at the regional level, is proceeding satisfactorily, but the apparent lack of co-ordination and information on the nature of the various groupings calls for measures that will check the divergent concepts at work.

The Resolution cited above highlights the need for a good deal more effective work so as to consolidate and develop both existing and future forms of economic co-operation in the Continent. It further emphasizes the need for and recommends the compilation of basic economic data that would enhance co-operative effort at all levels. With a view to fulfil this latter objective, the Resolution instructs the Administrative Secretary-General "to assemble and disseminate any statistical and accounting data relevant to the economic integration of Member States, to draw up in particular an inventory of the agricultural and industrial resources of the States and to make a study of their respective fiscal and customs systems as well as of their import and export structures, in order to help Member States in their efforts to integrate".

It is felt that the above instruction could be implemented on two plans :

- (a) A questionnaire to be despatched to Member States with a view to gather easily available statistical data, and
- (b) A study tour that would not only unearth information that was left out by Member States in completing the questionnaire but also complete the questionnaire on the spot if Member States (as is likely) do not comply with the request of filling the questionnaire forms.

Explanatory Notes (continued) :

This last item would call for Budgetary appropriations in the 1969/1970 fiscal year. Participation in ECA Sub-Regional Meetings and the covering of the OCAI annual gathering would also call for Budgetary appropriations.

(b) Participation in ECA Sub-Regional Meetings and the OCAI annual Conference

2. Trade and Development

Authority : Resolutions CM/Res.156, 157 and 158 (XI) passed by the Council of Ministers in its Eleventh Ordinary Session.

Description : It has come to widely realized that the rate of economic development in the developing regions of the world is a function of their international trade transactions in general and their export performance in particular. The United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) is the most important organ of the U.N. family of Specialized Agencies with regard to the promotion of exports in the developing countries. Its activities (Conferences, Working parties, Expert groups and Research work in the field) highlight the desirable patterns of commodity trade, preferences, shipping, etc. with regard to the development needs of the developing countries. How, generally speaking, the developing Third World can best finance its capital imports (necessary for its development programmes) through increased exports both in volume and money terms to the developed world is the overriding objective of UNCTAD. Continuous and effective participation in UNCTAD proceedings is thus necessary both for individual Member States and the General Secretariat of the OAU.



Explanatory Notes (continued) :

The Resolutions cited above recognize this necessity and :

Call for full participation in UNCTAD proceedings and support for its objectives ;

Instruct the Administrative Secretary-General "to extend all assistance possible" to the establishment of an expert group composed of the 12 African Members of the UNCTAD Board and the convening of a Meeting of this expert group with a view "to insure the implementation of the policies set forth in the Algiers Charter and to propose to OAU Member States appropriate methods for successful negotiations (vis-à-vis the developed world) within UNCTAD".

With a view to implement this last provision the Economic and Social Affairs Department of the General Secretariat has already started discussions with the appropriate division in the ECA. It has been agreed that a Joint Meeting comprising the 12 African Members of the UNCTAD Board and the OAU/ECA Ad Hoc Committee of Fourteen on Trade should be jointly called by the OAU and the ECA within the 1968/1969 Budgetary year. The Economic Commission for Africa (ECA) has intimated its willingness to finance this joint venture. Insofar, however that the ECA has to submit estimates for this item in its appropriation for 1969/1970 and insofar, as the Budgetary authorities might not approve the scheme in part or in toto, it has been found prudent to submit a partial coverage of the expenditures involved in the supplementary Budget for 1968/1969. (The Meeting is scheduled for January 1969). Part IV of this exercise will cover this item.

Over and above this item, the Secretariat would have to make appropriations for the participation and servicing of the Meeting of the African Group which will precede that of the Group of 77 in Dakar during the 1969/1970 Budgetary year.

CHAPTER I : This Chapter deals mainly with Personal Emoluments. Most of the increases reflect the normal annual increments in accordance with the Staff Rules and Regulations.

- (i) Sub-Head 7 - Telex Operator : The installation of Telex Machine linking other offices of the Organization of African Unity has necessitated the creation of a new post.
- (ii) Sub-Head 9 - Driver/Mechanics : The one additional Driver was formally being paid from the funds of the Committee of Five (Special Committee on Rhodesia) which has since been reamalgamated fully into the Committee of Eleven. The additional Driver has since been co-opted into the Secretariat.
- (iii) Sub-Head 12 - Security Guards : The movement of the Executive Secretariat Office to another building has necessitated the employment of 3 Security Guards to assist those provided for by the Tanzania Government.
- (iv) Sub-Head 13 - Gardener/Cleaner : There is a need to employ a Gardener/Cleaner to take care of the grounds of the new offices of the Secretariat.
- (v) Sub-Head 3 - Replacement of Motor Vehicles : There is a need to replace the existing Motor Vehicles whose road worthiness will soon be questioned by the Police. The Retrading in of the motor vehicles will greatly reduce Item III (6) in the Budget.

EXPLANATORY NOTESCHAPTER IECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DEPARTMENTA. ECONOMIC MATTERS.1. AN ALL AFRICAN TRADE FAIR.

Authority : Resolution CM/Res. 161 (XI) passed by the Council of Ministers in its Eleventh Ordinary Session.

Description : One of the most serious impediments to the economic integration of the Continent is the lack of substantial trade flows between Member States. To break out of the vicious circle of negligible inter-African trade, lack of meaningful sinews for integration and contact, together with the resultant attitudes retard integration, trade promotional efforts are called for.

If inter-African trade is minimal, developmental steps that could bring about the increased trade should be undertaken. Commodity publicity programmes, economic missions and a general strategy of getting to know our Continent and the potential of inter-African trade are needed.

In recognition of the above, the Council of Ministers passed Resolution CM/Res.127 (IX) in its Ninth Ordinary Session in Kinshasa (September 1967). This Resolution directed the Administrative Secretary-General "to organize an All African Trade Fair as soon as possible". Consequently, the Secretariat inscribed this item on the agenda of the Tenth Ordinary Session of the Council. In this Session, the Council decided that the Republic of Kenya be the host for the First All African Trade Fair. At the Eleventh Session, both the host country and the Secretariat submitted progress reports on the matter. Subsequently, the Council of Ministers passed Resolution CM/Res.161 calling on the host country to prepare a feasibility report on the staging of the Fair in Nairobi.

It is felt that apart from expenditures to be incurred on correspondence and on contacting Member States with regard to the form and magnitude of their participation in the Fair, the Secretariat would be forced to depute an Official to liaison with the relevant Kenyan Authorities as to the general pattern of the Fair insuring that in the preparations, the original objective of the Fair, i.e. the promotion of inter-African trade is not compromised. More specifically, the Secretariat has to work out with the Kenyan Authorities and would call for a representative of the Secretariat to visit Kenya at least twice within the 1969/1970 Budgetary year.

2. MONETARY CO-OPERATION.

Authority : Resolution CM/Res.160 (XI) passed by the Council of Ministers in its Eleventh Ordinary Session.

Description : The Resolution cited instructs the Administrative Secretary-General (together with the Executive Secretary of the ECA and the President of the African Development Bank - ADB) "to extend all assistance that may be needed by the African Governors of the IMF and IBRD".

With a view to implement this Resolution, the Department started discussions with the ECA and the ADB. It has finally been agreed

(in the last Joint Annual Meeting of the IMF and the IBRD) between those concerned namely the OAU, ECA and the ADB with the approval of the African Governors of both the IMF and the IBRD to establish a Secretariat that would prepare an "African position" on the burning issues of Monetary reform and the flow of development aid. This Secretariat would further service any meeting of the African Group that may be convened prior to the Joint Meeting of the IMF and the IBRD. The cost of this OAU/ECA/ADB Secretariat was estimated at US.\$ 6,000.00 to be equally shared by the Organizations concerned. Thus, the Secretariat's portion would amount to US.\$ 2,000.00. Over and above this expenditure item, it would be necessary to participate in the IMF/IBRD Annual Meeting.

3. SOCIAL AFFAIRS.

1. ALL AFRICAN TRADE UNION MEETING.

Authority : Resolution CM/Res.162 (XI) passed by the Council of Ministers in its Eleventh Ordinary Session.

Description : The Resolution reiterates the need for the establishment of an All African Trade Union Organization. Resolution CM/Res.162 (XI) now raises the question of aid that could be extended by the Secretariat to the existing movements (AATUF and AATUC) by instructing the Administrative Secretary-General "to examine the question of aid necessary" that would enable the two major movements to meet and discuss ways and means of reaching and understanding that would bring about the desired unity. To implement this instruction, the Department plans to call a meeting restricted, as a first step, to the leadership of AATUF and AATUC. This meeting would be composed of the two Secretaries-General and three Officials on each side. It would thus involve not more than eight persons.

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CHAPTER II  
SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL DEPARTMENT

1. CENTRES OF EXCELLENCE

(Please refer to Resolutions n°s CN/Res.116 (IX) and CN/Res.171 (XI).

(a) A Committee responsible for following up implementation of this programme :

In Resolution CN/Res.116 (IX), it was decided to "establish Training and Research Institutions (or Centres of Excellence) for training highly qualified personnel and for contributing to the acquisition of new knowledge in the specified scientific disciplines". In Resolution CN/171 (IX), it was decided to "establish an OAU Committee responsible for following up implementation of the programme to set up "Centres of Excellence in Africa". Taking into account the proposal below for a 3-man team of experts to look into, and to prepare a project plan for one (pilot) centre, it is considered that this Committee could hold one meeting in the 1969/1970 financial year to receive and consider the blue-print for one centre from the team of experts, and to make recommendations to the Council of Ministers and the Assembly of Heads of State and Government on the case. It is suggested that the Committee should be composed of five Members, but it is up to the Council of Ministers to agree on its composition.

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The meeting would be held in Addis Ababa, and if not, other costs would arise which would have to be met, and for which supplementary estimates would be submitted to the Council of Ministers.

**(b) Natural resources.**

The decision to establish Training and Research Institutions or Centres of Excellence in Africa was taken in 1967, vide Resolution CM/Res.116 (IX). The collection of general information by the General Secretariat has been completed, and it is necessary to have this sorted out by experts, who would put it in a form relevant to and useful for the proposed Centres of Excellence. Also in Resolution CM/Res.171 (XI) it was decided to establish an OAU Committee "responsible for following up implementation of the programme to set up "Centres of Excellence in Africa". This Committee cannot begin to function until more detailed and additional work is done on this programme. Such additional work would be done by experts. In line with the need to move cautiously in the establishment of Centres of Excellence - eight of which were approved initially - it is necessary for these experts to prepare a project plan for one Institution, which would serve as a pilot scheme for the rest of the programme. The Secretariat was advised that three African experts would be required to carry out the work involved in about three months. According to available information, the Institutions were drawn up in a list of priorities, and the Centre for Geology, Geophysics and Mineralogy (Earth Sciences) was considered as the one that should be established first to enable Member States to exploit more effectively their mineral wealth.

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It should be stated that, while several UN Specialized Agencies may consider assisting in this programme, many of them would want to see what the OAU can do on its own first before considering giving positive aid.

**2. OTHER EDUCATION MATTERS ARISING FROM THE JOINT UNESCO/OAU CONFERENCE ON EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN AFRICA**

In Resolution CM/Res.170 (XI), the OAU adopted "the recommendations of the Nairobi Conference on Education and Scientific and Technical Training in Relation to Development in Africa", and further requested "the Administrative Secretary-General to take appropriate action to

implement them ..."

(a) Educational Revolving Fund

In the Resolution adopted on the "Provision of facilities-laboratories, equipment, teacher training- and their joint and economic", the Conference requested "the OAU and ADB with the co-operation of UNESCO, to conduct detailed studies of the proposed establishment of an Educational Revolving Fund including its financing ... and present their studies to the Assembly of Heads of State and Government".

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For purposes of economy, the visit to UNESCO would be covered during other official trips provided for in the Budgetary appropriations, otherwise supplementary estimates will be submitted later should this prove not to be the case.

(b) Education Targets

The Conference recommended that "UNESCO, in co-operation with the OAU and ECA, prepare as soon as possible the documentation needed for a possible general revision of the previous educational targets ...". It was intended that such preparations should be completed within two years.

It would entail two Members of the Secretariat travelling to UNESCO Headquarters in Paris where records of educational performance of Member States are kept at present. It is most likely and would be appropriate that a meeting of UNESCO experts with OAU and ECA Officials be held.

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(c) Expansion of Higher (Scientific) Education.

The Conference adopted a recommendation which called for the convening "under the auspices of the Scientific Council of Africa of OAU and with the co-operation of the Association of African Universities, a Conference of African research workers to prepare the Ministerial Conference on science policy in Africa which UNESCO proposes to organize".

The Secretariat proposes to hold this meeting at the same time as that of the CSA itself. Provisions for the CSA meeting are made elsewhere. However, a token sum is included here to facilitate budgeting procedures in the event of any unforeseen expenses arising :

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3. ALL AFRICAN CULTURAL FESTIVAL.

In Resolution CM/Res.117 (IX), the OAU decided "to sponsor regularly an All African Cultural Festival of African Drama, Folksongs and Instrumental Music". The Festival is expected "to be self-financing". The first of such Festivals is to be held in Algiers, Algeria from 21st July to 1st August, 1969. Although subsequent Festivals will be organized and staged by the All African Cultural Council, the forthcoming one is being organized by the Administrative Secretary-General, assisted by a Preparatory Committee composed of eight States. While the expenses of the Festival are to be met from a different budget, the cost of the Secretariat team is as follows :

Concerned at the tragic and serious situation in Nigeria ;

Recognizing that situation as an internal affair, the solution of which is primarily the responsibility of Nigerians themselves ;

Reposing their trust and confidence in the Federal Government of Nigeria ;

Desirous of exploring the possibilities of placing the services of the Assembly at the disposal of the Federal Government of Nigeria ; -

Resolves to send a consultative mission of 6 Heads of State (Cameroon, Congo-Kinshasa, Ethiopia, Ghana, Liberia and Niger) to the Head of the Federal Government of Nigeria to assure him of the Assembly's desire for the territorial integrity, unity and peace of Nigeria.
