50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OAU**

**I. Introduction**

1. The Organization of African Unity (OAU) was established on 25 May 1963 in Addis Ababa, with the signing of the OAU Charter by representatives of 32 Member States. A further 22 Member States gradually joined the organization over the years, with the Republic of South Sudan becoming the 54<sup>th</sup> member *on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2011*???. The OAU aimed to promote the unity and solidarity of African States; co-ordinate and intensify their co-operation and efforts to achieve a better life for the peoples of Africa; defend their sovereignty, territorial integrity and independence; eradicate all forms of colonialism from Africa; promote international co-operation, giving due regard to the Charter of the United Nations and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights; and co-ordinate and harmonize members' political, diplomatic, economic, educational, cultural, health, welfare, scientific, technical and defense policies.

2. 25<sup>th</sup> May 2013 will mark the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the establishment of the OAU/AU and to this end, the Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the African Union decided that the celebration of this event be held at national, regional and continental levels with the aim of paying tribute to the generations of the Pan Africanists and the founding fathers of the continental organization as well as popularizing the African Union.

3. In cognizance of this historic milestone, the 16<sup>th</sup> ordinary session of the Assembly of the African Union (Assembly/AU/Dec. **361(XVI)**) decided that the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of the OAU/AU shall be celebrated in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, on the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2013. In this regard, the Assembly requested the African Union Commission to make the necessary arrangements for the celebration in close collaboration with Ethiopia and member States of the African Union. Similarly, the 18<sup>th</sup> ordinary session of the Assembly (Decision Assembly/AU/Dec. **412(XVIII)**) also declared 2013 as the Year of Pan Africanism and African Renaissance. The Assembly also encouraged member States and the Regional Economic Communities (RECs) to organize various events in close coordination with the African Union Commission to celebrate the Year of Pan Africanism and African Renaissance and to enhance the awareness of the new generation of Africans about the ideals of Pan Africanism and African Renaissance.

**II. Organizational structures**

4. Within its internal structures, the African Union Commission mandated the Conference and Event Organizing Committee (CEOC) to come up with detailed proposals on the activities to be carried out to celebrate this important event. In so doing, the Commission resolved to work closely with the Host Country, Ethiopia, and to sensitize all Member States to be fully involved in the celebrations both at the AU Headquarters and at regional and national levels. In compliance with the directive of the Commission, the Conference and Event Organizing Committee met on several

occasions to deliberate on the preparations for the celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the OAU/AU slated for 25<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

5. On its part, Ethiopia as a host to the then OAU/now the AU has attached great importance to the celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The Ethiopia Government, has established a National Organizing Committee (NOC) in July 2010, tasked with the responsibility of organizing the celebration event. The NOC is composed of all relevant stakeholders including sectoral ministries, state owned enterprises, Chambers of Commerce, Labor Union and a number of other professional associations. The NOC has set up seven (7) Sub-committees in charge of coordinating the major tasks to be undertaken to colorfully celebrate the event. The NOC has so far held 10 sessions and has managed to lay down the ground work for the celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

### III. Progress attained to date

6. The Ethiopian National Organizing Committee, under the chairpersonship of Ambassador Kongit Sinegeorgis, Permanent Representative of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to the African Union and UNECA, and the AUC Conference and Event Management Committee, under the leadership of Ambassador Jean Mfasoni, Secretary-General of the Commission, have exchange views on several occasions on how best the celebration events could be organized.

7. Upon the invitation of the Ethiopian side, the CEOC and NOC held their first joint meeting on 8 June 2012, at the Meeting Hall of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ethiopia. During the meeting, the two sides briefed each other on the activities that they have so far carried out to mark the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. The CEOC indicated that it has come up with a proposal of activities and a draft budget as well as formed working groups to celebrate this important event.

8. On the other hand, the NOC has indicated that it has prepared a draft Action Plan and budget to mark the celebration event, which have been submitted to higher authorities of the Ethiopian government for consideration and approval. The NOC has informed the CEOC that it has proposed the establishment of a Secretariat, which will run the day to day activities of the Committee. Once the Secretariat becomes operational, the NOC indicated that it will work closely together with the African Union Commission with a view to colourfully celebrating the event.

9. In their exchange of views, the two sides agreed on the need to identify the following:

- **Category I:** Activities to be undertaken by AUC;
- **Category II:** Activities to be undertaken by Host Country;
- **Category III:** Activities to be undertaken jointly by AUC/Host country through their respective committees;

- **Category IV:** Activities to be undertaken at regional and national levels.

10. During their meeting, the CEOC and NOC further decided as follows:

- i) The relevant Sub-Committees from both sides to meet and harmonize the activities which could be implemented together and come up with a joint Action Plan;
- ii) Each side also to develop an Action Plan of activities which would be carried and implemented separately;
- iii) Agreed to hold joint meetings on regular basis to review progress attained;
- iv) Agreed to produce joint reports for the information of the AUC and the Ethiopian Authorities as well as the Permanent Representatives' Committee (PRC);
- v) Also agreed to report together to the Executive Council and the Assembly;
- vi) Prepare jointly a Draft Decision to be considered by AU Policy Organs.

11. In line with the Decision of the Assembly, the two sides have agreed to involve African Embassies accredited to the African Union in Addis Ababa at an early stage so as to mark this historic event with the wider participation and contribution of all stakeholders.

#### **IV. Recommendations**

12. The two sides agreed to submit the following recommendations to the Council:

- i) To strengthen the good working relationship between the Ethiopian National Organizing Committee and the AUC Conference and Event Organizing Committee;
- ii) The two parties should start mobilizing resources for financing the activities for celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the OAU/AU as outlined in the Joint Action Plan and in addition mobilize necessary financial, human and material resources that would enable the Commission run a series of media campaign for the promotion of Peace and Stability as well as economic development throughout the continent;
- iii) The Commission and the Ethiopian side should endeavour to work together with all the Member States and the Regional Economic Communities (RECs) as well as other AU Organs to organize various activities, including media events, debates and competitions in schools and universities, public opinion surveys, sessions in local and national legislatures, and other activities to celebrate the Year of Pan-Africanism and African Renaissance

and enhance the awareness of the new generations of Africans about the ideals of Pan-Africanism and African Renaissance;

- iv) AU Policy Organs to authorize the Commission to fund at least half of the planned and agreed activities, through arrears of contributions as they have not been catered for in the 2013 Budget;
- v) AU Policy Organs to authorize the Commission to mobilize extra-budgetary resources from potential donors, such as voluntary contributions from Member States, International Partners of the African Union, private sector and other partners;
- vi) Member States to provide voluntary contributions for the financing of the various activities planned for the Celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and organize in their respective countries activities and events in this respect.

## V. Funding Mechanisms

13. The funding of the celebration activities will be borne by African Union Commission, the Ethiopian Government and member States of the AU as follows:

a) Activities identified to be undertaken by AUC

14. The AUC will fund these activities. The estimated cost related to these activities is USD 1,354,000.00. It is proposed that this budget be met through:

- Arrears from Assessed Contributions (PRC to be consulted on the issue);
- Member States Voluntary Contributions;
- Mobilizing resources from partners, private sector and other interested parties.

b) Activities identified to be undertaken by Host Country

15. These activities will be funded by the Ethiopian Government to the tune of ETB 94,278,653.76 (approximately US \$5.3 million).

c) Activities identified to be undertaken jointly by AUC/Host country through their respective committees

16. The activities under this category will be sponsored by both the African Union Commission and the Ethiopian Authorities. The discussions are ongoing between the two sides to identify joint activities. The beautification of the Surroundings of the AU Compound which will be implemented in phases will cost USD 500,000

d) Activities identified to be undertaken at regional and national levels

**17.** The activities under this category will be sponsored by individual Member States to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of OAU/AU. Discussions should commence with Member States to identify such activities.
