

DECISION OF THE ASSEMBLY OF HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT
ON THE OFFER OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA TO HOST
THE SECRETARIAT OF THE AFRICAN COMMISSION ON
HUMAN AND PEOPLE'S RIGHTS

The Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the Organization of African Unity, meeting in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, in its Twenty-fourth Ordinary Session, from 25 to 28 May 1988,

Having examined the offer of the Republic of The Gambia to host the Secretariat of the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights,

Recalling the vital contribution of The Gambia to the conception and elaboration of the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights,

Recalling further that by virtue of this fact Banjul, the capital of The Gambia, has lent its name to the said Charter,

Recognizing the commitment of The Gambia to the respect and upholding of the Rule of Law and Human and Peoples' Rights:

1. WISHES to thank the Republic of The Gambia for its generous offer to host the Secretariat of the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights;
2. DECIDES unanimously to site the Secretariat of the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights in Banjul, The Gambia.
