AMISOM condemns the Mogadishu car bomb attack

Mogadishu-December 3, 2014; The Special Representative of the Chairperson of the African Union Commission (SRCC) for Somalia, Ambassador Maman S. Sidikou, strongly condemns the barbaric Improvised Explosive Device (IED) car bomb by Al-Shabab earlier today in Mogadishu.

"We condemn today's attack near the airport in Mogadishu. This attack shows the enmity and total disregard for life by Al-Shabaab who continue to simply kill innocent people," Ambassador Sidikou said
