**REPORT ON ELECTION OF TEN (10) MEMBERS OF THE PEACE  
AND SECURITY COUNCIL OF THE AFRICAN UNION**

## **REPORT ON THE ELECTION OF TEN (5) MEMBERS OF THE PEACE AND SECURITY COUNCIL OF THE AFRICAN UNION FOR A TWO (2) YEAR TERM**

1. The election of the Members of the Peace and Security Council of the African Union (PSC) is based on the provisions of the Constitutive Act of the African Union, the Protocol Relating to the Establishment of the Peace and Security Council of the African Union (the Protocol) and the Modalities for Election of Members of the Peace and Security Council adopted by the Policy Organs of the Union in March 2004 (the Modalities).

2. It should be recalled that by Decision Assembly/AU/Dec.106 (VI) adopted in Khartoum, the Sudan during the Sixth Ordinary Session of the Assembly in January 2006, the Assembly delegated its power to elect members of PSC, under Article 5(2) of the Protocol, to the Executive Council.

3. In conformity with the provisions of Article 5 (1) of the Protocol, the PSC is composed of fifteen (15) Members elected on the basis of equal rights, in the following manner:

- i) Ten (10) Members elected for a term of two (2) years; and
- ii) Five (5) Members elected for a term of three (3) years in order to ensure continuity.

4. *In accordance with the Modalities*, the regional representation of the fifteen (15) members in the PSC is as follows: **Central (3), East (3), North (2), South (3) and West (4)**.

5. The current elections relate to the elections of only ten Members for a two (2) year term. It should be recalled that the term of the following ten(10) Members elected in January 2018 for a two (2) year term, will expire in March 2020:

- a) **Central Region** : Equatorial Guinea and Gabon
- b) **Eastern Region**: Djibouti and Rwanda
- c) **Northern Region**: Morocco
- d) **Southern Region**: Angola and Zimbabwe
- e) **Western Region** : Liberia, Sierra Leone and Togo

6. In accordance with Article 5 (3) of the Protocol, a retiring Member of the PSC is eligible for immediate re-election.

7. In this regard, during these elections, in accordance with the prescribed composition the PSC, the following Members shall be elected:

- Central Region : two (2) Members
- Eastern Region : two (2) Members
- Northern Region : one (1) Member
- Southern Region : two (2) Members
- Western Region : three ( 3)Members

8. The criteria to be taken into account when electing members of the PSC is provided under Article 5 (2) of the PSC Protocol and it includes the following:

- i) commitment to uphold the principles of the Union;
- ii) contribution to the promotion and maintenance of peace and security in Africa – in this respect, experience in peace support operations would be an added advantage;
- iii) capacity and commitment to shoulder the responsibilities entailed in membership;
- iv) contribution to the Peace Fund and/or Special Fund created for specific purpose;
- v) respect for constitutional governance, in accordance with the Lomé Declaration, as well as the rule of law and human rights;
- vi) participation in conflict resolution, peace-making and peace building at regional and continental levels;
- vii) having sufficiently staffed and equipped Permanent Missions at the Headquarters of the Union and the United Nations, to be able to shoulder the responsibilities which go with the membership.

9. A table recapitulating the Membership of the PSC since March 2004 is herewith attached to this report.

10. It will be recalled that the Commission through its Note Verbale referenced BC/OLC/23.21B/2010.19 dated 24 July 2019, invited States Parties to the Protocol to submit candidates on or before the deadline on 30 November 2019. Further, the Commission, through Note Verbale reference number BC/OLC/42.23/2496.19 dated 19 November, 2019 reminded Member States of the election and the set deadline. Finally, the Commission through its Note Verbale reference number BC/OLC/23.21b/2597.19 dated 03 December, 2019 extended the deadline to 17 December, 2019, for the Eastern and Southern Regions.

11. The Commission would like to inform the Executive Council that the candidatures received from the States Parties to the Protocol are as follows:
